It is now 13 years since Rachel and James started Mikwano and we've had many changes since then, both in the trustees and the projects that

we've supported. But, most importantly, with your help we've changed the lives of countless Ugandan children. That is a massive achievement.



Last week we received the progress report from Providence Home, detailing the successes and progress of the children there. It was heartwarming to read. Their lives have been transformed by the huge investment made by the Watson Family Charitable Trust and our our donors and they're now seeing the results of clean water, solar power and proper sanitation, all things that we take for granted.

Children at Uganda Martyrs School have been supported through primary school with basics such as books, uniform and food.

Mikwano has continued to support the Mukisa Foundation, funding a special needs teacher and an occupational therapist.

We have also funded some individual children including Patricia who was left disabled by treatment for cancer. Sadly, her mother died this year, so life will be even more difficult for Patricia now.
