As always, a huge thank you to all our donors. You have made the difference to many children's lives. One of our trustees, James, spent a few weeks in Uganda earlier in the year and supervised and monitored all our projects.

This year we have sponsored a total of 183 children in our Primary Schools Project in

Kampala. We have been helped by SPOWE, who have monitored some children, as they have volunteers in Kampala.



At Providence Home, with the help of the Doris Field Trust, we funded a chicken project, which is running extremely well.



3 children are also being supported by private donors.

We are currently applying for funds from a law firm to help with building new, much needed, accommodation for the elderly.



In addition we support the Mukisa Special Needs Centre by funding the teacher's salary, scholastic materials and medicines.

Mukisa is an exceptionally special place and the enthusiasm of the teacher and children is infectious. There are also two more special needs children, Richard, a deaf boy and Patricia, who was left disabled by cancer

treatment, whose education is sponsored by Mikwano.

We continue to provide formula milk for St Philomena's Babies' Home.
