There we were delighted to see the huge improvements that have been made, mostly by the extreme generosity of The Watson Family Charitable Trust, including a new building for the elderly and installation of solar power. Sr Angeline has done a wonderful job in improving the lives of these children, who are there because they are disabled, destitute or orphaned.

We have also supported Mukisa, a day centre in Kampala for disabled children and their parents, and continue to fund around a hundred children's primary education.
